I'll jump right into it. The proposed redevelopment of Carmel Heights is everyone's biggest concern at the moment It's a daunting project, and we have a large battle ahead of us to get a more reasonable proposal for the property. In the fall of 2018, an ad-hoc committee of the SFRA called the Carmel Heights Redevelopment Committee (CHRC) was established.

At that time, we developed a strategy for fighting this project and once the application was submitted to the City at the end of August, we started implementing it. Both Councillor Matt Mahoney and MPP Rudy Cuzzetto suppor our objections to this proposal, and we are actively in contact with each of them We have also engaged other individuals and groups who have experience fighting unreasonable developments throughout Mississauga.

That being said, we all need to accept that some form of redevelopment will happen at Carmel Heights eventually, no matter what. The current building is no longer up to code, and the property is far too valuable to just remain as is. Our main objective, is chipping away at this proposal (or having another one brought forward) to something more in line with the rest of the community and the concerns of our residents.
