Sherwood Green Skating & Hockey Rink

Great news! The City of Mississauga Recreational Department has provided the go-ahead to install ice skating rinks at parks across Mississauga. We have been contacted and the City has agreed to install one rink in Sherwood Green. Unfortunately they did not approve the two rinks we normally have and they have standardized the size of all rinks across the city. However, we provided guidance to the size the rinks should be.

We have also been informed by Matt Mahoney that the City will be contributing \$750 toward the cost of the rink liner as part of the community benefit fund. Thank you to Bruno and the SFRA for lobbying on our behalf!

In next couple of months we need to prepare the area, fix the nets and gather a list of people who want to help start up and maintain the ice. If you would like to volunteer, please email bibs.inc@gmail.com. Please remember that students receive community hour credits for working on the rink.


We look forward to lots of volunteers (many hands make light work) and lots of skaters! We will let everyone know if the plans for the skating rink change due to COVID-19.

Coronavirus Update

Sadly, the coronavirus has not magically gone away as someone south of the border (which is still closed to travel) said it would. Due to the recent increase of cases in Peel and the GTA, the Ontario government has once again restricted the private gathering limit to 10 people indoors and 25 people outdoors. Social circles of up to 10 people have been cancelled. Masks are now mandatory in all public indoor areas. For your health and the health of others, please:

- **Stay 2 metres away** from everyone outside your family circle.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water or use hand sanitizer.
- **Wear a mask** when physical distancing is difficult and where they are mandatory.
